

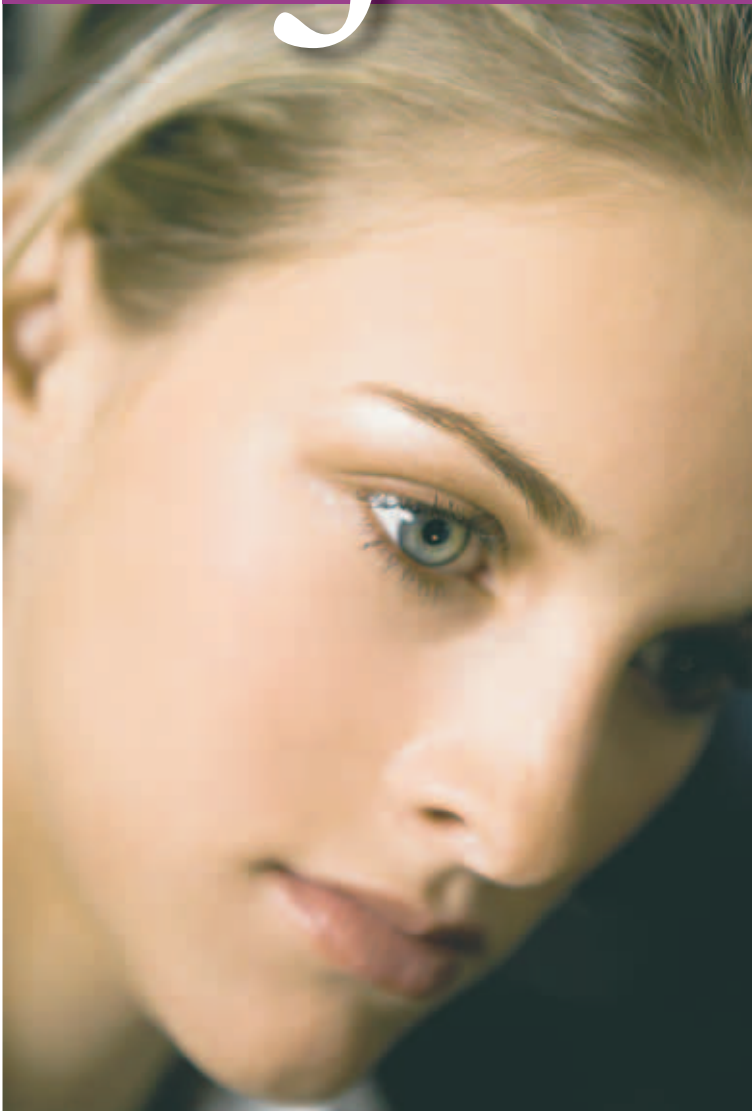

TURN BACK THE HANDS OF TIME...

There is a range of non-invasive procedures available now to rejuvenate tired face and turn back the hands of time. Once upon a time patients gave lots of thought and consideration to the prospect of indulging in a rejuvenating procedure to enhance their looks. The old adage of "no pain, no gain" applied and it took a certain courage to hide away and to emerge, suddenly more youthful. This is certainly no longer the case. These days there is a multitude of treatments available to revive and refresh the appearance of the face. The patient can spend as little as 30 minutes undergoing a procedure, which often will have spectacular results.

Botox has become an extremely popular, non-invasive rejuvenation procedure, which takes only minutes and produces incredible results within a couple of days of the treatment. In the upper face, Botox injections between the brows and the forehead can soften and smooth the lines and wrinkles and give a real lift to the forehead. This can brighten the eyes especially if the tiny crow's feet are treated as well. There is no downtime; patients can go back to work immediately afterwards. After the first treatment, patients are usually so happy with the results they return ever 4-6 months to effortlessly maintain the youthful effect.

For the treatment of fine lines and deeper wrinkles in the lower face, to enhance lips soften wrinkles there is a range of injectable fillers available. Collagen, Restylane, Perlane and the newer Juvederm and Sculptra with results lasting several months to now years. Aquamid is permanent filler that is becoming more popular with men and women who have been using temporary fillers, who love the results and want

to retain the improvement permanently. Again, these procedures take less than an hour.

The texture of the skin is often another feature which most men and women seek to improve. Microdermabrasion, Glycolic peels and Intense Pulsed Light Therapy are procedures that require a minimum of fuss, no down time and from which patients can return to work immediately. Each of these procedures or a combination can substantially improve the appearance of acne scars, pigmentation as a result of sun damage, spider veins on the face and neck can also be treated.

Generally these procedures give optimum results after a series of treatments. Patients can plan to have them at their convenience but they don't become a chore and there is no need to take time away from work.

For deeper wrinkles and acne scarring there is the treatment of laser resurfacing. This remains the gold standard of treatment.

This does require some time off work but the results can be quite spectacular.

Recently ReCell developed by Professor Fiona Wood has recently been introduced to the practice to treat scars and hypopigmented areas such as vitiligo.
